TREASURER'S REPORT-Briana Moore

Current balances, per Bank OZK, are:

Grand total: **\$79,168.43**

Karina Price went to Bank OZK to continue processing of interest-bearing CD. The 20K will be taken from the Light Uptown fund.

Briana Moore requested a vote to donate funds and splashpad equipment to City of Hot Springs. The City of Hot Springs will match the 45K donated by PACA Splash Pad fund.
